

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA CARRIED OUT WITH THE VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

Pursuant to art. 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 (the "GDPR"), the following information regarding the video surveillance system installed at our headquarters.

1. DATA CONTROLLER:

The Data Controller of the personal data collected through the video surveillance devices is **NRG GLASS MOULDS S.R.L.**, with registered office in Via Strada Nazionale, 38/a, 46036, Borgo Mantovano (MN).

2. PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING:

Personal data collected through video surveillance are processed for the purpose of protecting company assets.

The legal basis of the processing is:

- by art. 6, par. 1, letter f) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR), as the processing is necessary for the pursuit of the legitimate interest of the data controller to protect the company's assets.

3. PROCESSING METHODS AND STORAGE TIMES:

The images collected by the video surveillance cameras are recorded and stored for a maximum period of 24 hours, except for the need for further storage in relation to holidays or office closures or special needs for further storage in relation to investigations by the Judicial Police or requests from the Judicial Authority.

The data are processed with IT tools and by adopting appropriate technical and organizational measures to guarantee their security and confidentiality.

4. SCOPE OF COMMUNICATION AND DISSEMINATION OF DATA:

The data collected will not be disseminated and may only be communicated to:

- Law enforcement or judicial authorities, upon explicit request.
- Axians Italia Spa, as the supplier of the video surveillance equipment, is authorised, on the basis of the contract for the appointment as data processor, to access the cameras remotely.

Data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area.

5. NATURE OF THE PROVISION:

The provision of the data in question is mandatory if access is made to the filmed area.

6. VIDEO SURVEILLANCE REPORTING:

The installation of video surveillance devices is indicated by special information signs placed near the cameras, in compliance with the indications of the Privacy Guarantor.

7. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECTS:

In relation to the images recorded through the video surveillance system, the data subject may exercise the following rights towards the Data Controller:

- Right of access: Art. 15 of the GDPR allows you to obtain confirmation from the Data Controller as to whether or not data concerning you is being processed and, if so, to obtain access to them.
- Right to erasure: Art. 17 of the GDPR allows you to obtain from the Data Controller the erasure of personal data concerning the data subject without undue delay if one of the reasons provided for by the law exists.
- Right of limitation: Art. 18 of the GDPR allows you to obtain from the Data Controller the limitation of processing when one of the hypotheses provided for by the law occurs.
- Right to lodge a complaint: Article 77 of the GDPR recognises the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of your data infringes the GDPR .
